Drawing & Watercolor

Objective: This course will focus on two points:

Practice for drawing and experimenting with new materials (charcoal on kraft paper)

Introduction to the use of watercolor and use of materials.

Topics	Materials
<p>-Review of the basics of drawing: Geometric shapes, proportion, light and shadow, blurring, lines and strokes,</p> <p>-First drawings: Climbing frog and toucan.</p> <p>Note: If there is time to make one more drawing, students can choose which one.</p>	<p>-Black and white charcoal.</p> <p>-Paper kraft paper bond.</p> <p>-Support tablet</p> <p>-Blender.</p>

Topics	Materials
<p>-Drawing of Papagayo</p> <p>-Howler monkey drawing</p> <p>Note: If there is time to make one more drawing, students can choose which one.</p>	<p>-Black and white charcoal.</p> <p>-Paper Kraft paper bond.</p> <p>-Support tablet</p> <p>-Blender</p>

Class 3	
Topics	Materials
<p>-Introduction to watercolors, how to use them</p> <p>-Plotting exercises: Solid, wet, transparency, wet-on-wet, volume, layers, gradient, splattered.</p> <p>-Effects exercises with other materials: Salt, plastic, crayon, alcohol, paper.</p> <p>- Line drawing coloring.</p> <p>Note: If there is enough time, students would paint a small landscape.</p>	<p>-Watercolor.</p> <p>-Watercolor brushes</p> <p>-Watercolor paper</p> <p>-Paper towel</p> <p>-Salt</p> <p>-Piece of plastic</p> <p>-Alcohol</p> <p>- Cotton swab</p> <p>-Dropper</p> <p>- Tape</p>

Class 4

<p>-Paint small examples of elements in landscapes.</p> <p>-Snowy landscape with the use of salt.</p> <p>- Landscape of mountains using gradient and layers.</p> <p>Note: If there is enough time, students will be able to make other landscapes based on the examples in the book</p>	<p>-Watercolor.</p> <p>-Watercolor brushes</p> <p>-Watercolor paper</p> <p>-Paper towel</p> <p>-Salt</p> <p>-Piece of plastic</p> <p>-Alcohol</p> <p>-Cotton swab.</p> <p>-Dropper</p> <p>- Archival ink</p> <p>-Tape</p>
